The Childcare Resource and Research Unit welcomes the Ontario government's commitment to build a system of universally accessible, affordable, high quality early childhood education and child care over the long term. The five-year plan announced today recognizes that these elements are interconnected and that a comprehensive system-building approach is needed.
