Description:

The Child Care Coalition of Manitoba received funds from Status of Women Canada's Women's Program, for an 18-month project titled "Changing Child Care in Manitoba Research Tools, Skills and Action Planning."

Among other activities, we undertook social and economic impact studies of childcare in three regions of the province (Parkland, Thompson and St-Pierre-Jolys), following up on the Winnipeg campaign begun with our 2004 Time for Action Report, and action planning at the provincial level.
