- for children between the ages of 4 and 13 who are currently attending preschool or elementary school in an English- or Frenchlanguage public or private school

Parents will not have to pay for the emergency daycare services.

No meal services will be offered, and no snacks will be provided. Please prepare a lunchbox for your child. Only cold meals and thermoses will be accepted.
