Reconciling History

Beginning in 2014, Beechwood Cemetery, Funeral, and Cremation Services and the Beechwood Cemetery Foundation [9] have collaborated with local First Peoples to create the Reconciling History program. Beechwood has partnered with the [First Nations Child & Family Caring Society](#) [10] and [KAIROS Canada](#) [11].

With the ultimate goal of education and awareness, Beechwood strives to show both sides of history by not excluding the impact many prominent Canadians buried in our grounds had on First Nations, Métis, and Inuit. Rather, Beechwood chooses to highlight both their achievements and their shortcomings to provide a holistic view of history.
