Will centres have enough money to pay educators if parents are only paying \$10/day?





Even though families will be paying **less** for child care, the new money from the federal government will mean centres will get **more** operating funding from the government. Centres will end up with the same, or more, funding to pay their staff and other expenses.





Will ratios increase under the \$10 a day plan?



NO

No, there are no changes to ratios in the plan. Ontario recently completed a 5-year review of the Child Care and Early Years Act and chose not to change ratios and group sizes.

Will the municipality still have a role in child care?





Ontario is the only province that has municipalities playing a role in child care, and it's not going anywhere in a new agreement! Municipalities are important partners in the child care system, and that won't change.







Will for-profit centres be able to reduce their fees under the \$10/day plan?





Yes, all licensed child care (home child care, for-profit centres, non-profit centres) will be eligible to receive funding to reduce parent fees.
