The Australian Government has released the draft National Care and Support Economy Strategy.

The draft strategy focuses on paid care and support services in:

- aged care
- disability care and support
- veterans' care
- early childhood education and care (ECEC).

The draft strategy outlines a vision for a sustainable and productive care and support economy that delivers quality care and support with decent jobs. This means:

- person-centred services that recognise those accessing care and support as individuals and deliver quality outcomes
- secure, safe jobs with decent wages, conditions and opportunities for career development
- a care and support economy that has functioning markets, sustainable funding and generates productivity gains.

Sitting beside the strategy will be a road map and a series of action plans. The action plans will be developed iteratively and will outline practical steps towards the strategy's objectives.
