On March 23, 2011 the Saskatchewan government tabled their provincial budget for 2011-2012.

Budget highlights: child care

- \$2.1 million to develop 500 new child care spaces, to a total of 12,700 spaces;

- \$4.0 million to support the development of

500 new child care spaces of which some will be designated to post-secondary institutions; and,

- \$2.0 million to develop PreK programs in existing schools. This funding is in addition to \$2.6 million in operating funding to support an additional 40 PreK programs.
