Excerpts from press release: The Stephen Harper government needs to give up its tax cut addiction and invest in solutions to pressing problems facing Canadians, says the 2008 Alternative Federal Budget (AFB), released by the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives. It puts Canadians' long-term interests ahead of short-term political gain, ensuring our national investments benefit the majority and strengthen our nation economically as well as socially. "In addition to being a key component of the eventual achievement of quality for women in the workforce, child care investment and services are key to the social and economic security of all Canadians." "Child care requires a secure and adequate source of federal funding, so legislation will be combined with significant investments in ELCC services through a dedicated child care social transfer."
