At a meeting in Paris on 2-3 May 2011, Ministers exchanged views on the serious short- and long-term challenges citizens are facing today and on what they could do to address them.

Session 1: Social policies for the recovery [3]

They discussed the social impact of the global economic crisis and compared approaches to adapt social policy to support the recovery.

Under the broad umbrella of family policies, they discussed good practices in removing barriers to family formation, enhancing the wellbeing of children, promoting gender equality in employment, and innovative approaches to improve service delivery for vulnerable families.
