The Ontario government has proposed changes to key child care regulations including reductions to adult: child ratios and increases to group sizes. In response, an [open letter](#) <sup>[2]</sup> outlines the research on these important program elements and raises concerns about the proposed change's impact on quality and on early childhood staff. The letter urges the Minister of Education Ontario government to engage in fuller consultation in a broader, holistic approach to ECEC policy development.
