The provincial government is granting three groups in the Northwest a total of almost \$1.4 million to create new child care spaces.

The money is going to the Kermode Friendship Society and Rock Christian Community in Terrace and the Gitanmaax Band Council at Hazelton.

A news release announcing the grants says the Kermode Friendship Society will create 62 child care spaces, using its almost \$500-thousand grant.

The Rock Christian Community is getting \$380-thousand for 56 spaces.

And the Gitanmaax Band will create 34 spaces, using \$500-thousand.

In all, the government has announced \$8.2 million for 26 organizations around the province.
