2013-2014 Budget Highlights

- The total budget for 2013-2014 will increase by \$1.6 million to a Total of \$230.9 million.
- Through the school board amalgamation process, approximately \$750,000 will be realized on an annual basis.
- An additional \$250,000 will be budgeted for the early learning centres for 2013-14.
- The Best Start program is being expanded to 36 months with additional funding of \$60,000 last year and a further \$60,000 this year
