Prince Edward Island

- Kindergarten in ECEC sector universal since
 2000
- September 2010 All 5 year olds left for full day in school system
- Most experienced ECEs recruited to be K teachers

Critical Questions

- Governance
- Quality
- Access
- Sustainability



Governance

- Education sector broad in-service
- Largely private operation how to create a system?
- Created publicly managed, community based system – with options for current centres
- Early Years Centres, private centres, infant homes
- Data Strategy

Quality

- Appreciation for ECE qualifications
- Need for post-secondary courses FAST!
- Curriculum framework
- Quality measures
- ECE wage grid significant increases
- Professional Development
- Parent involvement

Access

- 2x Canadian average for access for 0-6 year olds
- Cost a factor \$5K more for 4 years ECEC than for 4 years full time university
- Regulated and reduced parent fees
- Central registry
- Expansion based on need
